

FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – March 2025

From March 1, 2025 through March 31, 2025, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 94%. The save rate for dogs was 89% and for cats it was 99%.*

Since August 2018, FBCAS has maintained a 90% save rate for the pets entering our shelter.

- 68 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program
- 7 dogs and one cat were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs

Dogs:

- · One puppy was humanely euthanized due to severe injury
- · One dog was humanely euthanized due to severe injury or illness in foster care
- · Three dogs were humanely euthanized due to severe injury or illness in foster care
- · Five dogs were humanely euthanized due to aggression towards staff and public
- · One dog was humanely euthanized at the request of their owner as part of a head-to-lab bite investigation

Cats:

· One cat was humanely euthanized due to severe injury or illness

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
