FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – July 2025

From July 1, 2025 through July 31, 2025, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 93%. The save rate for dogs was 94% and for cats it was 93%.*

Since August 2018, FBCAS has maintained a 90% save rate for the pets entering our shelter.

- · 89 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program.
- 13 dogs and 8 cats were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.

Dogs:

- · One dog was humanely euthanized due to severe illness.
- · One dog was humanely euthanized due to aggression towards staff and public.
- · Four dogs were humanely euthanized as part of a bite investigation.
- · Two dogs were humanely euthanized as part of an owner-surrender bite investigation.

Cats:

- · Two neonatal kittens died in shelter due to unknown causes.
- · Five neonatal kittens died in foster failure to thrive.
- · Four newborn kittens died shortly after arriving at the shelter.
- · One cat was humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injury.

Our dedicated staff would like to thank all our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month.
