FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – September 2025

From September 1, 2025 through September 30, 2025, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 93%. The save rate for dogs was 90% and for cats it was 94%.*

Since August 2018, FBCAS has maintained a 90% save rate for the pets entering our shelter.

- · 79 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program.
- 9 dogs and 1 cat were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.

Dogs:

- · Two newborn puppies died in shelter.
- · One newborn puppy was humanely euthanized for severe illness/injury.
- · One dog died in foster from severe illness.
- . One dog died in shelter from severe illness.
- · Four dogs were humanely euthanized due to aggression towards staff and public.

Cats:

- · One kitten died en route to the shelter due to unknown causes.
- · Three kittens died in shelter due to illness/failure to thrive.
- · Four kittens were humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injury.
- · One cat died in shelter due to severe illness or injury.
- · One cat was humanely euthanized due to severe injury.
