FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – December 2025

From December 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 90%. The save rate for dogs was 86% and for cats it was 94%. *

Since August 2018, FBCAS has maintained a 90% save rate for the pets entering our shelter.

- 70 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program.
- 12 dogs were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.

Dogs:

- Two dogs died en route to the shelter due to severe injuries.
- One dog died in kennel from unknown illness.
- Four dogs were humanely euthanized due to aggression towards staff and public.
- One dog was humanely euthanized due to severe injuries.
- Five dogs were humanely euthanized as part of head to lab bite investigations.

Cats:

- One kitten was humanely euthanized in shelter due to illness/failure to thrive.
- Two cats died in kennel due to severe illness/injury.
- Three cats were humanely euthanized due to severe illness/injury.

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
