FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – February 2026

From February 1, 2026, through February 28, 2026, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 93%. The save rate for dogs was 92% and for cats it was 94%. *

Since August 2018, FBCAS has maintained a 90% save rate for the pets entering our shelter.

- 85 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program.
- 11 dogs and 2 cats were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.

Dogs:

- Four dogs were humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injuries.
- One dog was humanely euthanized due to severe injuries.
- One dog was humanely euthanized at the request of their owner for aggression.

Cats:

- Two cats were humanely euthanized due to severe injuries.
- Five cats were humanely euthanized due to severe illness.

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
