FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – March 2026

From March 1, 2026, through March 31, 2026, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 93%. The save rate for dogs was 90% and for cats it was 96%.*

Since August 2018, FBCAS has maintained a 90% save rate for the pets entering our shelter.

- 115 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program.
- 12 dogs and 2 cats were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.

Dogs:

- One dog died after surgery complications.
- Two newborn puppies died shortly after birth.
- One puppy was humanely euthanized due to severe injuries.
- Two dogs were humanely euthanized at the request of their owner for aggression.
- Four dogs were humanely euthanized due to aggression towards staff and public.

Cats:

- One cat died due to severe injuries.
- One cat died during surgery.
- Two kittens were humanely euthanized due to severe injuries or illness.
- Three cats were humanely euthanized due to severe injuries or illness.

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
