FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – May 2026

From May 1, 2026, through May 31, 2026, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 90%. The save rate for dogs was 88% and for cats it was 92%.*

Since August 2018, FBCAS has maintained a 90% save rate for the pets entering our shelter.

- 68 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program.
- 14 dogs and 2 cats were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.

Dogs:

- One puppy was humanely euthanized due to severe illness.
- One dog was humanely euthanized at as part of a head to lab bite investigation.
- Five dogs were humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injury.
- Six dogs were humanely euthanized due to aggression towards staff and public.

Cats:

- One neonatal kitten died in foster.
- Five neonatal kittens died in shelter – failure to thrive.
- One cat died in en route to shelter due to severe illness or injury.
- One cat died in in shelter due to severe illness or injury.
- Six kittens were humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injuries.
- Three cats were humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injuries.

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.

*Best Friends Community Dashboard formula: [(Live Intakes, including Owner Requested Euthanasia)-(Died in Care)-(Lost in Care)-(Shelter Euthanasia)-(Owner Requested Euthanasia)] divided by Live Intakes
