FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – June 2026

From June 1, 2026, through June 30, 2026, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 90%. The save rate for dogs was 88% and for cats it was 91%. *

Since August 2018, FBCAS has maintained a 90% save rate for the pets entering our shelter.

- 92 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program.
- 9 dogs were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.

Dogs:

- One puppy died in care due to severe illness.
- Two puppies were humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injury.
- Two dogs were humanely euthanized due to aggression towards staff and public.
- Four dogs were humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injury.

Cats:

- Two kittens died in foster.
- Three I kittens died in shelter due to severe illness or injury.
- Seven kittens were humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injuries.
- Five cats were humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injuries.

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
