FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – July 2026

From July 1, 2026, through July 31, 2026, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 91%. The save rate for dogs was 89% and for cats it was 92%.*

Since August 2018, FBCAS has maintained a 90% save rate for the pets entering our shelter.

- 82 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program.
- 13 dogs and 1 cat were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.

Dogs:

- One dog died in care due to severe illness or injury.
- Seven dogs were humanely euthanized due to aggression towards staff and public.
- One dog was humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injury.
- One dog was humanely euthanized as part of a head to lab bite investigation.

Cats:

- Six kittens died in foster due to failure to thrive.
- One kitten died in shelter due to severe illness or injury.
- One kitten died en route to the shelter due to severe illness or injury.
- Six kittens were humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injuries.
- One cat died in care due to severe illness or injuries.
- One cat was humanely euthanized as part of a bite investigation.
- Two cats were humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injuries.

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
